#### Fundraising

- Boon Supply
  - ▶ \$729.52 Profit
  - ➤ Link is still open, will extend until November 15
  - Look into increased shipping cost for larger orders
- Calendar update
  - > Will not make the October  $15^{th}$  deadline, aim to make the  $31^{st}$  instead
  - > This means calendars will ship December 30 for distribution at school in January
  - ➤ Add WSA ad to the top of the photo page

#### **Enrichment/Events**

- Book Fair: October 30-November 4
  - > Need volunteers to assist with set up, as well as run the book fair
  - Open the fair during the Trunk or Treat, then have it open Monday through Friday before school (7:30-8:15am) and after school (2:45-3:15pm, until 4pm on Friday)
  - Coordinate volunteers through Scholastic website, where a coordinator requests slots, the link is published, and parents make an account to sign up.
  - ➤ Melissa to ask Angela about using the library for the fair, with the hallway as a plan B.

- > Need to charge tax this year, and there is a new fuel surcharge
- Teachers have opted to do book bins instead of wish lists for the classrooms; Althea to send an email to Chris to remind teachers to pick books for parents to purchase from the bins
- Trunk or Treat: Sunday, October 30<sup>th</sup> 5-7pm
  - > Jenn to produce flyer to distribute in Friday Folders
  - > Additional listings on Front Porch Forum and an ad in the Caledonian Record
  - > Request assistance from the Fire Department with setting up the parking lot
  - Erin and Jenn volunteered to be on candy duty
  - ➤ Costume Parade at 5:30, Rachel to run the contest
  - Budget \$90 for the event: Boxcar and Caboose gift certificates for the top three costumes (\$20, \$15, \$10) and \$25 for best trunk; remainder for Erin to cover costs associated with coffee station
- Eighth Grade Common Good
  - > Connected with Waterford Historical Society to clean up one of the cemetaries

## New Business

- Tax ID
  - > The tax ID used in previous years is for the Caledonia Coop, not WSA
  - > WSA does not have a tax ID, but can apply for 501(c)(3) with the Secretary of State
    - Application costs approximately \$150
    - Treasurer would have to do a filing at the end of each year
    - Failure to file for three years results in termination
  - $\succ$  voted to have Jenn apply
